Organisation/ Communication Gary has been able to organises and respond appropriately to the needs of the young people he works with by ensuring that essential appointments are met and that he has been in attendance to support in advocating and allowing the young person to feel empowered when making decisions.
Through this I have observed that at times this can be difficult to manage and challenging. However Gray has been able to demonstrate through his good communication skills by developing trusting working relationships that he has been able to respond to the presenting needs of the young people he supports.
Gary is able to show that he can be sensitive to the needs of the young people and takes into account that at times they present at various levels of crisis. Gary has been able to work within their pace to achieve best outcomes in the interest of the young people. This is by organising and meeting timescales and sharing relevant information to the professional network.
Communication Gary has been able to respond in crisis to young people and has ensured that safeguarding concerns are shared with the professional network. This has been achieved through emails , monthly reports and regular phone calls.
Gary has ensured that he is able to provide early intervention support and has attended all professional meetings required giving clear and concise information to the professional arena.
