Instead, we will be adapting the term "Supported Accommodation." In light of these changes, all staff members have been assigned a short course provided by the National Children's Bureau. This course will provide an explanation of the upcoming changes and the new Quality Standards.

In accordance with the new Supported Accommodation Regulations, we are currently reviewing our Statement of Purpose, Young Person's Guide, and Policies. This review will provide everyone with the opportunity to read and provide feedback over the next few weeks.

Katrina is developing a notice board for families each month will focus on a different topic that staff feel the families need more knowledge around. This month is starting with healthy eating.





